

South Korean National Police University

Being one of the 76 members of INTERPA (International Association of Police Academies) Korean National Police University (KNPU) is a National University located in Asan, South Korea. KNPU was established in 1979 and recruited first freshman in 1980 to educate professional police executives who have a strong sense of justice and leadership.

Now, KNPU provides undergraduate programs, postgraduate programs, recruit training programs, and other education programs. Undergraduate program is focused especially on the study of law and public administration and takes 4 years. Postgraduate program includes 2-year master's program and 3-year doctoral program which are offered in three departments: Investigation, Criminology, and Public Safety. KNPU also provides police cadet program, special appointment program, and police manager course.

It has also expanded its academic networks with diverse foreign universities and institutions by hosting international seminars, making international exchanges, and running education programs for foreign police officers.
