

Police Academy of Montenegro

Being one of the 73 members of INTERPA (International Association of Police Academies), Police Academy of Montenegro in Danilovgrad was founded in 2006 and since 2012, it has acquired status of vocational school. Being unique law enforcement education institution in Montenegro, it has not wasted its time but has been constantly developing. In addition to its primary mandate which is education for police and prison officer, the Academy has managed to license large number of educational programs, specialist training and training in the field of security and protection, primarily for members of law enforcement agencies: Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Justice, Tax Administration, local self-government bodies, etc.

During the two years of free education, cadets for Basic Education Program for a policeman/policewoman are provided with accommodation, food, educational and professional literature, teaching materials and teaching aids, modern classrooms. The Sports Center has a hall that meets FIBA standards for hosting indoor sports. Within the Sports Center there is an artificial rock wall, a fitness hall and two modernly equipped shooting rooms. The practical training takes place on a polygon that covers an area of 2,100 m² with eight container-type buildings, intersections equipped with light signalization, a mini-city district simulating the working environment of a police officer and other facilities needed for professional and specialist training for security and protection services.

The Police Academy also provides training in the area of protection of persons and property.
